

Steps to Building Evangelistic Courage


Welcome to "7 Days of Courage." This initiative is designed to foster spiritual growth, equipping you to effectively share your faith in Christ.

THE STRUGGLE IS REAL

Evangelism can be daunting, so we want to focus on a number of areas where we can all take steps to be bolder about our faith. Some people are natural evangelists and have a natural boldness to share their faith with others, but many Christians aren't.

WHAT PREVENTS PEOPLE FROM SHARING THEIR FAITH?

In the Jesus film projects' Multigenerational survey on Evangelism in 2020, 1600+ Christians were asked why they didn't share their faith, and the number one reason was fear (see graph below). Overcoming fear is the biggest challenge and there are ways you can gently build your courage and overcome your fear.





HOW TO COMPLETE 7 DAYS OF COURAGE

We need to be intentional about sharing our faith, so we want to encourage you to take some steps to build your evangelistic courage.

MAKEA PLAN

Choose six steps from the following Steps of Courage suggestions and fill out the Steps to Courage participation card. Look to complete these six steps over the week of your Church's event.

ALONG THE WAY

Keep updating your Steps of Courage card as you complete the challenge. Keep a record of the challenges and outcomes of each step.

SHARE STORIES

On Sunday we encourage you to share with your church your journey and some of the things God has done in your life during this time.

A FINAL STEP

As a final step we encourage you to consider extending your evangelistic reach by Sponsoring a family with Mission Without Borders. Partner with us to reach people for Christ like Orhan's family (see story on page 5).

STEPS TO BUILD YOUR EVANGELISTIC COURAGE

Even if you share your testimony or something God has done in your life, this can be a powerful seed you share with those who don't know Christ.

FRIENDSHIP EVANGELISM

Develop a friendship with someone who is not a Christian. Having non-Christian friends provides the opportunity to shine the light of the Gospel into their lives.

BE BRAVE AT WORK

Tell someone at work who doesn't know you're a Christian, that you're a Christian.

SERVANT EVANGELISM

Do something to help someone in need that doesn't know Christ. Offer to do some gardening, mow a lawn or clean a car for a non-Christian neighbour.

PRAYER WORKS

Offer to pray for an unsaved person who's sick.

BAKING AND TREATS

Bake a cake or buy some treats for a neighbour who is not a Christian.

HOSPITALITY

Invite a non-Christian neighbour over for dinner.

WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

Put a word of encouragement into a card and into the letterbox of a non-Christian neighbour.

VISIT THE ELDERLY

Visit an elderly person you know, who doesn't know Christ.

VOLUNTEER

Help at a Soup Kitchen at a local Church or homeless shelter.

WORK WITH YOUR NETWORK

Share the good news of Jesus with a non-Christian family member or someone you have built a relationship with.

DISPLAY YOUR FAITH

Wear a Christian t-shirt or Christian wristband to work or in a public place.

CHRISTIAN DECOR

Decorate Your Home and Car with Christian decor. Like preaching the word through your clothes, you can also decorate your space to reflect your Christian faith.

SOCIAL MEDIA

Share some faith-related encouraging posts on Social Media

BIBLE DISTRIBUTION

Give away some free mini pocketsized Bibles. You can get some from your local Christian bookstore.

INVITE

Invitea non-Christian to Church or a Christian outreach event.

PRAYER WALK

Walk around your neighbourhood and pray for your non-Christian neighbours.

INTERCESSORY PRAYER

Develop a prayer listof non-Christians and pray for them regularly.

TESTIMONY

Share your personal testimony with someone who doesn't know Jesus.

TALK ABOUT CHURCH

Tell a friend at work your plans to attend Church on the weekend or how Church went on the weekend.

TAKE THE OPPORTUNITY

Initiate a conversation about the Lord with someone next to you on public transport (bus, train, uber, plane etc.)

READ YOUR BIBLE IN PUBLIC

Read your Bible on your lunch break or at a Café, many times this can be a conversation starter.

PRAYER CHALLENGE

Gently challenge a non-Christian friend to pray with an open heart "God, if you are real, reveal yourself to me."

INVOLVE GOD IN YOUR CONVERSATIONS

Whenever you compliment someone who isn't a Christian, thank God in the same sentence so instead of saying, "you're talented", say "God's blessed you with so much talent."

TEXT MESSAGE

Text your non-Christian friend or associate a Bible verse to encourage them to overcome the problem they are going through.

CHRISTIAN BUSINESS BOOK

Giveyour non-Christianbusiness associate a business book based on Biblical principles.

REVELATION

Ask God to show you something about a non-Christian person that you can share with them.

STREET OUTREACH

Get involvedinastreet outreach with your local Church.

VISUALLY PRAY IN PUBLIC

How powerful is it to see someone praying in public? You can do that, too. Silently bow your head and pray before meals, before tests, or anytime you feel inclined.

CREATE YOUR OWN STEP

There are so many steps we can take to build evangelistic courage. Maybe you have one of your own steps you can create for yourself to add to your list!



ORHAN'S STORY THE POWER OF PARTNERSHIP

A young man in Bosnia-Herzegovina becomes a Christian thanks to the witness of Mission Without Borders and our partner Church.

WHERE IT BEGAN

Orhan's family struggled with poverty when he was growing up in Mostar, Bosnia-Herzegovina. His mother, Marina, worked as a hairdresser and also as a cleaner for a local company. His father was unemployed but picked up any manual work he was offered. Orhan grew up sharing a small house with 11 other family members: his parents, his sister who is five years younger, his grandparents, and his uncles, and aunts.

The house had a living room, bedroom, kitchenette and inside toilet (no bathroom). Orhan, his sister and parents slept in the bedroom at night, and the other family members in the living room.

Orhan's family were enrolled in Mission Without Borders' family sponsorship programme. As a result, Orhan had a childhood filled with MWB's Summer Camps, special children's events, and later on, youth meetings. His faith had its ups and downs, but Orhan always had a sense of God's hand on his life and was drawn to Christianity because of the people he knew.

Growing up in a Muslim community, Orhan would never have been exposed to the Bible and its truths were it not for the supporters that send our Mission Without Borders team.

As Orhan shared his testimony at the baptism, he said:

"I've been thinking about baptism over the last two or three years and I'm glad that I'm doing it right now."

A BIT OF BACKGROUND

At Mission Without Borders "we enable and encourage people to lift themselves out of poverty, always sharing the hope that is found in Jesus Christ."

We started out over 60 years ago as Underground Evangelism smuggling Bibles behind the Iron Curtain. We now work across Albania, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Moldova, Romania and Ukraine to help people break the destructive cycle of poverty. While the context where we work has changed significantly in the last 60 years, our Mission has stayed the same – reaching people for Christ.

We want to use our background, skills and experiences in the Mission field to encourage Churches in Canada to reach people for Christ as well.
